# **NAAATT Annual Awards 2017 Ceremony**

Several bright track and field stars were honoured at the Radisson Hotel this Saturday as the National Association for Athletic Administrations of Trinidad and Tobago (NAAATT) hosted an Awards Ceremony for 2017 performances.

Leading the way were women's standout Michelle Lee Ahye who won the Women's

Athlete of the year after breaking the national 100m record at the Open Champs this year and having a consistent season in the Diamond League along with being a finalist at the World Championships in London 2017. On the men's side, breakout sensation Jereem Richards won the men's version. It was just reward for the after being among the world leading times in the 200m throughout





the year culminating in a bronze at the World Championship, along with the vital role he played in the gold medal winning 4x400m team at the same games.

These performances were just two of 17 "Outstanding Performances in 2017" recognised on the night in what has been a good year for athletics under the auspices of the NAAATT. Special awards were also heaped upon Para-Athletes Nyoshia Cain and Akeem Stewart for their medal winning performances in 2017.

Senator Ian Roach delivered the feature address and commended the NAAATT for its sterling efforts over the past year. His

daughter lanna Roach, a budding shot-putter, won the award for Female Youth Athlete of the year. Adell Colthrust, who recently won the Junior Sportsman of the year at the T&T Olympic Committee Awards, was the Male Youth Athlete of the year.

Other awardees included Khalifa St. Fort for the Female Junior Athlete of the year after winning the sprint double at both the Commonwealth and Pan-Am, Junior Championships and Jerod Elcock who got the Male Athlete of the Year. Both would be expected to make the transition from junior to senior as well as Jereem Richards has and ensure that the conveyor belt of talent continues for Trinidad and Tobago.
